Site Assessment and Design

If you are planning to create a mini wildflower meadow from scratch, or wish to enhance an existing wetland, woodland or grassland habitat with planting, Eadha can undertake a site survey, to establish what species are already present and what species could be effectively introduced. We will then advise on an appropriate species mix and proceed to propagate plugs plants, shrubs and trees grown from locally sourced seed and cuttings wherever possible. We will then buy in the remainder of the seed from commercial suppliers. We therefore advise that you get in touch with us as early in your project as possible, bearing in mind that seed is generally collected in late summer and autumn and cuttings in late winter. While we do retain some general stock of trees and plants in our small nursery, we generally grow to order. If you are looking for something specific, we may have it in stock and it is worth inquiring. Please get in touch to discuss your ideas and we will provide you with a proposal and quotation.

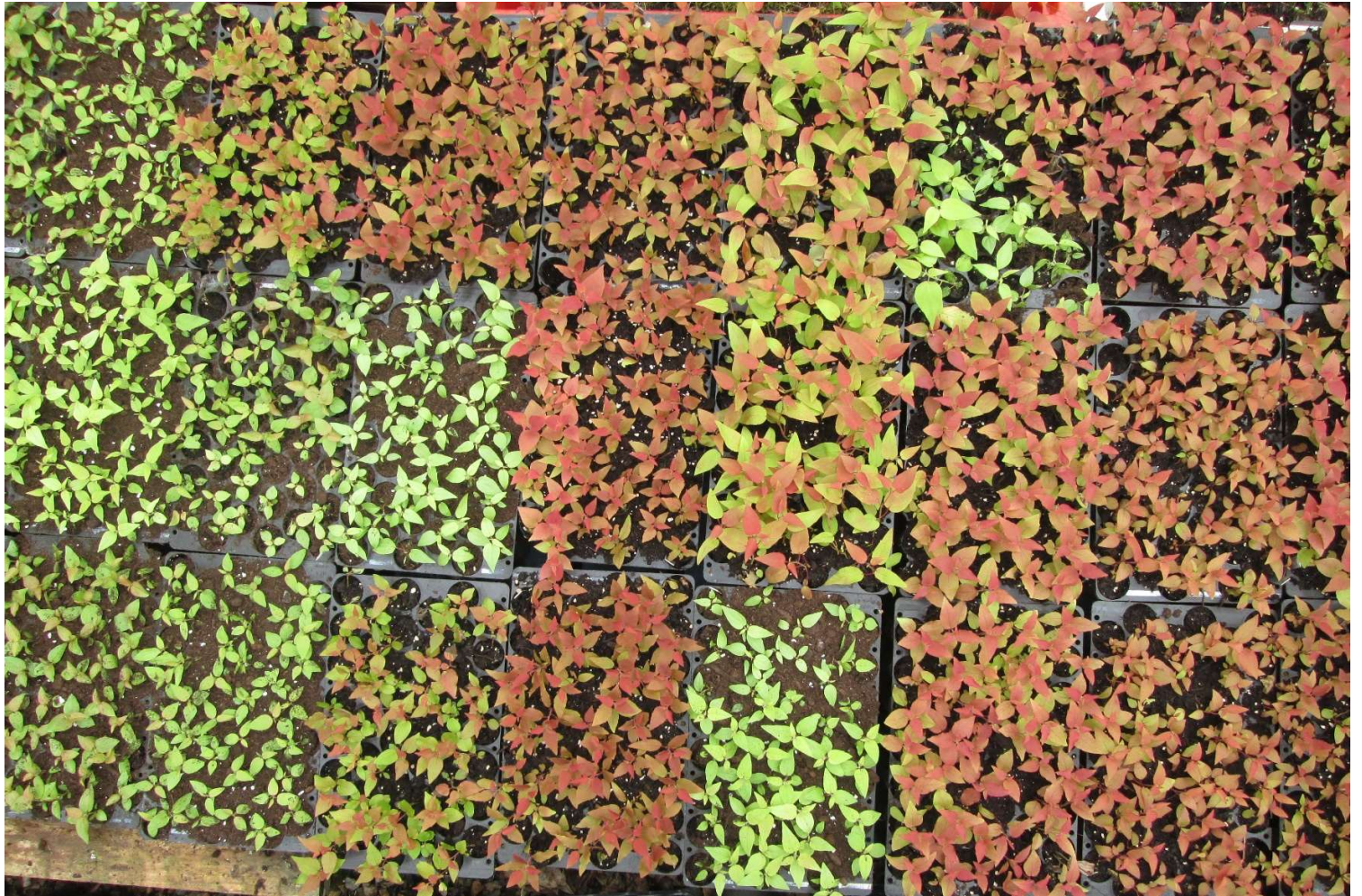
